- \$160 Junior League (13-14) **Tryout required**

- Openings are limited and are filled on a first come, first served basis. Remaining openings available to new players.
- **Open registration for new players is Tuesday & Wednesday, January 8th & 9th from 6:30-9:00 pm at Kentwood High School. 25800-164th Ave SE—Covington**
- New players must bring an original, certified copy of birth certificate and 3 proofs of residence (e.g. copy of driver's license, phone, cable, electricity bill)
- Baseball Minors "A", "AA" & Softball Minors teams are formed on the basis of equal distribution of age, neighborhood school residence and geographic location. Due to registration numbers and age distribution, players living in the same neighborhood may play on different teams. Baseball Minors "AAA" teams will be formed by age and distribution of talent via evaluation.
- Participation in the fundraiser is mandatory. Baseball/Softball Minors "A" players are required to sell approx. \$72 for the fundraiser, all other players in all divisions are required to sell approx. \$144 for the fundraiser. Players may "opt" out of fundraiser by paying \$75 (Baseball/Softball Minors "A" division: \$40) - due at the time of registration.
- Kent Little League is an all volunteer, non-profit youth baseball/softball organization chartered through Little League, Inc. Funds are generated through members fees, fundraisers, and community/business sponsorships.
- Each players' family is expected to volunteer a minimum of six hours throughout the season for the successful operation of the league.
- There will be a \$25 fee for returned checks. Please contact the treasurer, if needed.

### DIVISION INFORMATION

**Players Age is determined by how old Player will be on:**  
**Boys 4/30/08 & Girls 12/31/07.**

- Baseball Minor "A" & "AA"- practices start early March; season starts mid-April; pictures & jamboree on Opening Day—March 15th.
- All other Baseball and Softball divisions : practices start late Feb; season starts on opening day: March 15th.

### BASEBALL DIVISION RULES

- 1) 8 year olds may elect to play Minors "A" or "AA" depending on experience.
- 2) 9 year olds who have exceptional baseball skills, whose parents feel would be better challenged at a higher level, may elect to request an evaluation to be advanced to Minors "AAA". Evaluations will be January 26th. (see website/newsletters for updates or changes) **Evaluation process is mandatory and determines if the 9 yr old will be placed in Minors "AAA".**
- 3) **All 10 & 11 year old players must be evaluated.** Evaluations will be January 26th. (see website/newsletters for updates or changes)
- 4) 10 & 11 year old Players opting to try out for Majors and are not drafted to a team will automatically be placed on a Minors "AAA". **All 12 year olds must try out for Majors; \*All 12 year olds must play in Majors (a waiver must be submitted and approved by the KentLL Board of Directors and District 10 District Administrator for a 12 year old to play in baseball Minors "AAA")**
- 5) Baseball Majors tryouts are scheduled for February 2nd and 9th (see website/newsletter for updates and/or changes) - Attendance at both try out dates is strongly suggested; **a minimum attendance at one try out is required.** Juniors/Seniors and FastPitch tryouts will be posted on the KentLL website. Check frequently.
- 6) "Returning Player" means a player that has previously played in Kent LL, in the regular spring season. **(If your player has only played Fall Ball they must register as a New Player)**

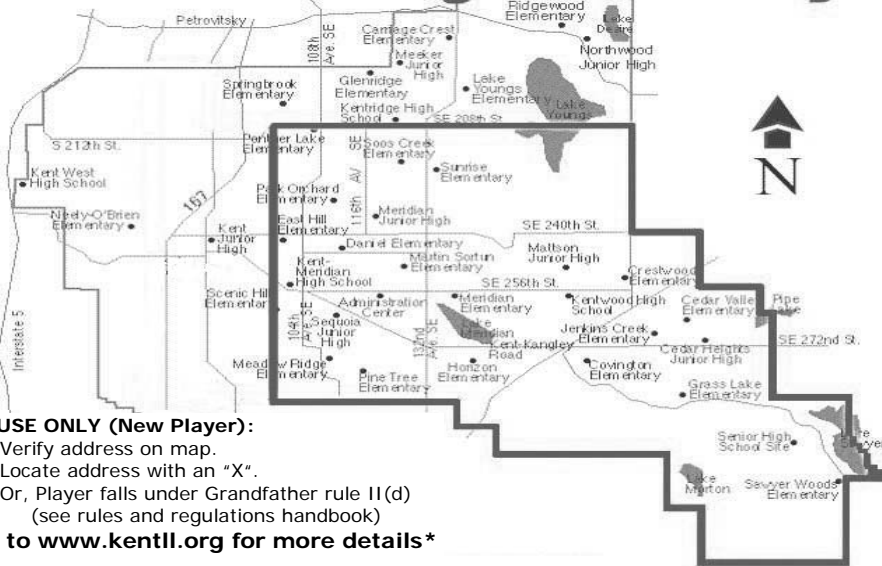
