Kent LL Tee Ball Bylaw Rules

General Rules and Guidelines

- 1. All games shall be played in accordance with the Official Little League Rule Book and the following bylaw playing rules and regulations.
- 2. A tee ball baseball shall be used in lieu of a hardball.
- 3. The manager shall place ten players (if available) in the field while on defense.
 - a. With ten players, four players shall occupy the outfield.
 - b. Players shall be rotated such that all players experience an infield position for at least one inning per game.
- 4. Continuous batting order rule applies.
 - a. Changing the batting order from game to game is required to vary the base running experience.
- 5. A hit ball is a "fair" ball that moves six feet from the batters tee.
- 6. No on-deck batters are allowed. The next batter shall not leave the dugout until the play is complete and the coach has the ball
- 7. When a fair ball is hit, that player runs to first base and stops.
 - a. Each successive hit, all players move 1 base at a time (there are no outs)
 - b. The last batter "hits a home run" and the bases clear to end the inning
- 8. Stealing bases is not permitted.
- 9. Coaches may be on the field to instruct the players
- 10. No games shall be rescheduled due to team count. Games shall be played with whoever shows up combine players with other teams necessary to allow the game to be played.
- 11. Each coach shall be held responsible for the conduct of their players, themselves, and their spectators.
 - a. The managers have the right to ask any offender(s) to leave the field. Any such incident is to be reported to the VP of Baseball.
- 12. Alcoholic beverages, or firearms, tobacco products, e-cigarettes, and vaping devices are prohibited at all games and practices.

Pre-Game Procedures

- 1. Coaches shall review the rules and regulations and, when necessary, establish the field boundaries and characteristics to the particular playing field.
- 2. The home team is responsible for layout of the field, including bases. Layout will be completed 15-20 minutes before the scheduled start of the game.
 - Bases must be breakaway per Rule 1.06
- 3. The home team shall provide (1) new balls for the game. The visiting team shall provide (1) backup ball.
- 4. Weather and field conditions prior to game The coaches shall inspect the field prior to play to determine if the field is playable per our Inclement Weather policy

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Game Timing and Completion

- 1. The actual start time will be the scheduled start time with the following exceptions:
 - a. Fields are not accessible/playable.
- 2. A game will consist of three (3) innings or 45 minutes max.
- 3. Each half inning shall end when all players have batted
- 4. Rain if, in the coaches' opinion, rain is hampering the game, play will be stopped.

Tee Use

- 1. The manager or coach shall ensure the player is standing properly in the batter's box and place the ball on the tee at the appropriate height for the player
- 2. The at bat cannot end on a foul ball.

Equipment Regulations

- 1. Bats must be a Tee ball bat with a USA stamp
- 2. Helmets are required anytime a bat is in hand
 - a. It is best practice to not have players hold bats in the dugout and only grab it on their way out to bat.
- 3. It is recommended that all male players wear a hard cup.

Scorekeeping and Reporting

1. No score is kept.

Post-Game Responsibilities

- 1. Both teams must police all playing and spectator areas after each game for garbage.
- Home team must drag the field and put away the bases and tee.
 - If there is a game after your game, the equipment shall remain, but dragging or spot raking is required to maximize the field conditions (Only exception is if there is a game

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
