

Kent Little League Social Media Policy

1. Purpose

Kent Little League (KLL) uses social media platforms, including but not limited to Facebook and Instagram, to promote league activities, highlight achievements, and foster community engagement. This policy outlines guidelines for reasonable and responsible social media use by KLL representatives, parents, guardians, and participants.

2. Photo and Video Use

- KLL may post photos and videos of games, events, and activities to celebrate and promote the league.
- KLL may use images where a child's features are not discernible unless otherwise discussed.
- While we take precautions to avoid featuring children's faces when requested, some group photos (e.g., team photos) may include your child.
- KLL is not responsible for photos added to comments on official posts by KLL or shared on non-KLL-affiliated pages.

3. Opting out of Social Media Posts

If you wish your child to not appear on our social media platforms, please, email registrar@kentll.org. As a 100% volunteer run organization we will do our best to monitor our platform. Please read below for parent expectations.

Parents who choose to opt their child out of KLL social media posts must actively manage their child's exclusion from photos and videos. This includes:

- Informing their child's coach and team manager of their preference.
- Ensuring their child steps out of group photos or videos intended for KLL's social media.
- Helping their child understand and follow this policy.
- Acknowledging that KLL will make reasonable efforts to honor requests but cannot control images shared by other parents, spectators, or outside organizations.

By taking an active role, parents help maintain a positive experience for all players while allowing teams to celebrate their achievements.
